Dear Suppliers,

Intel safety begins and ends with each one of us. That means all of us—employees, suppliers, and communities—have a tremendous responsibility to implement the highest level of care to ensure the health and safety of everyone working across our facilities.

Intel suppliers and their respective workforce are required to prioritize and comply with all environmental, health and safety (EHS) requirements. I want to re-emphasize the critical EHS function of pre-task planning, which is a core expectation of all workers. When we plan and assess the work in advance, potential hazards are identified, and we can implement the necessary safety measures for every job task.

Your Action: Our expectation is that all suppliers implement methods to verify that proper planning occurs for all work activities, appropriate controls and approvals are in place and action plans are followed. If there are changes to the work plan, conditions or work environment, the work must stop until a revised action plan has been developed to mitigate any additional hazards prior to resuming the work.

To reinforce safety, we will continue conducting audits to monitor compliance with our safety requirements. Failure to uphold safety expectations and standards can lead to disciplinary action, including worker suspension, removal from sites or disqualification of an individual or a provider company.

We expect your close attention to this important matter to ensure training and compliance are prioritized across your workforce. Together with you and your commitment to safety, we can maximize the care and wellbeing of our collective teams.
