

Intel Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam Site RBA VAP – Summary Findings

In 2014, Intel's assembly and test facility in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, underwent the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC), now known as the Responsible Business Alliance (RBA) Validated Audit Process (VAP). The VAP provides an independent (3rd party) comprehensive social and environmental assessment of a company's performance against the RBACode of Conduct, local laws, and regulations. No audit findings were identified in the areas of labor, ethics, or environmental. Four minor findings related to health and safety were identified, all of which have since been closed.

Below is a high-level summary of those four minor findings:
